Aim: To provide first aid training to carers to safely manage the scene, carry out the necessary checks and maintaining the airway, breathing and circulation of the injured party. You will learn the required skill to treat bleeding and fractures, burns and head injuries. Participants will be able to provide basic life support (CPR) and will be skilled in treatment of sprains, strains and recognising concussion and compression.

Course Duration: 1-day course 6 hours done onsite

Participants: Minimum 8 people

Certification: All successful candidates will receive a certificate valid for a period of 2 years
